Information about the registration process

This guide is intended to help psychology students of the University of Bremen* with the registration process for PsyStud.Please read the information carefully before you register for the first time.

First-time registration

If you have not yet used PsyStud, please enter your access data for the online tools (e.g. Webmail, Seafile, StudIP) of the University of Bremen in the registration field (see Figure 1). You have received these access data from the University with your semester documents. If you do not have them, please contact the Centre for Networks at the University of Bremen. This step is necessary to identify yourself as a student of the University of Bremen. If the initial registration does not work despite having received your access data, please contact the administration (psystud@uni-bremen.de).
